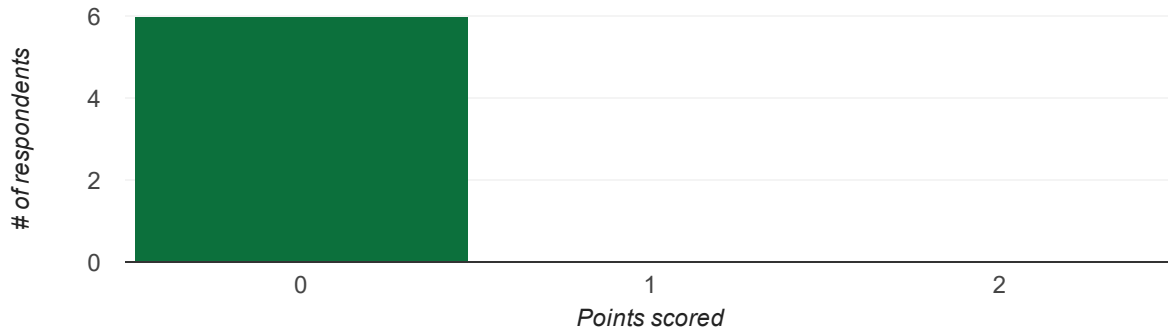

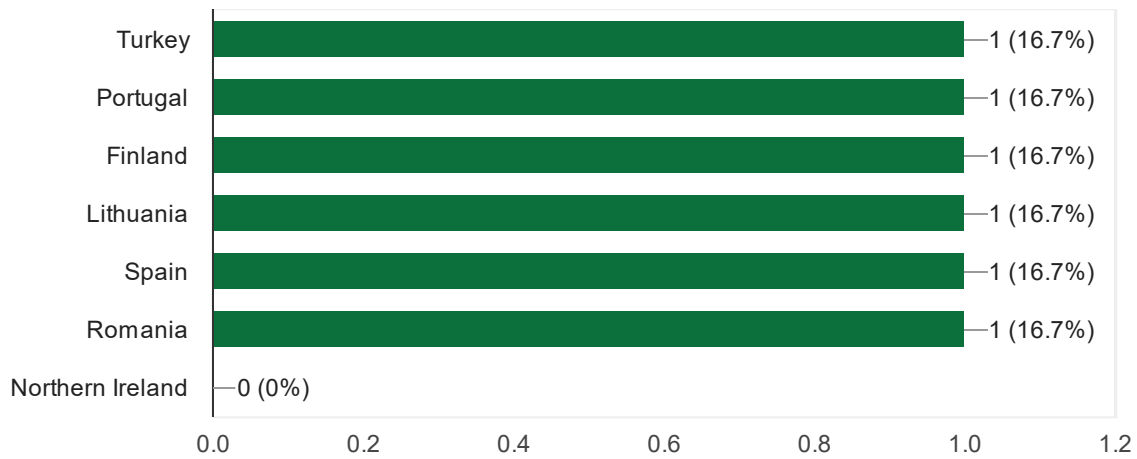

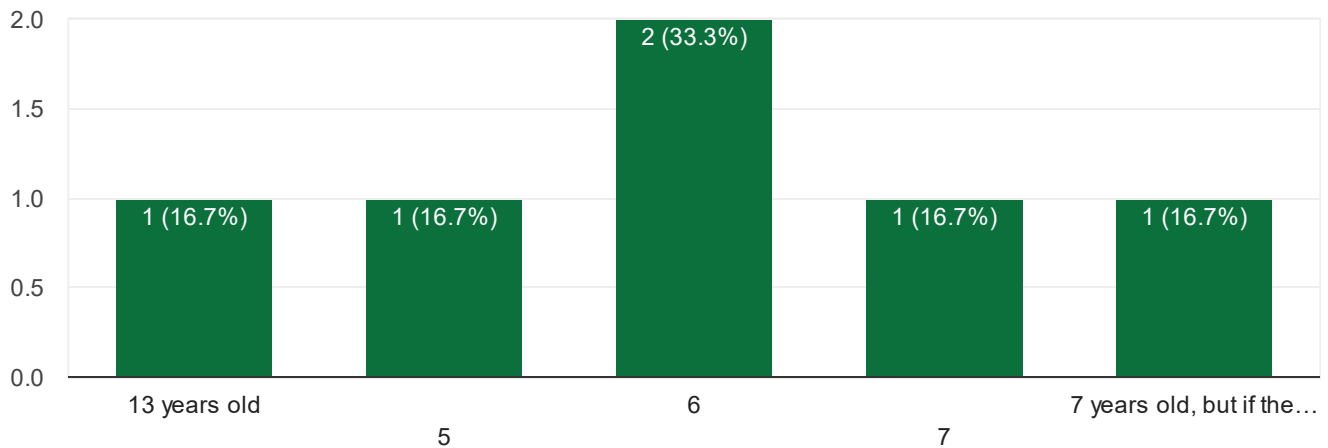

We only have one support teacher for all the SEN children in our school (about 20 in total). The teachers in each class prepare extra materials for the SEN children, adapted to their needs. Sometimes, depending on the needs of the child, the parent is allowed to stay in class.
